LA for Fair Lending Activities November 2011 to June 20, 2012 1. First organizational meeting at JSRI offices on November 16, 2011. Louisiana Budget Project, ASI Federal Credit Union, LA Community Reinvestment Coalition, Center for Responsible Lending, LA Catholic Conference, Jesuit Social Research Institute and the Archdiocese of New Orleans Office of Justice and Peace were represented at the meeting. 2. This group gradually expanded and met through conference calls on January 18, February 7, February 28, March 19, and nearly weekly during April and May, 2012. The Center for Responsible Lending has been an active partner throughout. LA for Fair Lending met face to face on April 25 at the Baton Rouge office of American Association of Retired Persons, Accomplishments thus far include: • Collaboration in early development of coalition partners. • Developed statement of purpose and goals. • Agreed to three phase strategy: 1) Educate, organize, and mobilize LA citizens; 2) Political Organizing and education of elected officials; and 3) Write legislation, gamer co-sponsors, mobilize constituencies, and pass legislation. • Collaboration on research and education, especially the LANO Conference and Family Impact Seminar on March 8-9, 2012. 3. Louislana AARP hosted a June 20 Strategic Action Planning meeting facilitated by Mary Baudouin, Social Ministries Director, Jesuit Province of New Orleans. This meeting achieved the following: • Created an Organizing Committee (OC) and voted for the following members to serve in positions as executives of the OC: Director: Alex Mikulich, JSRI Legislative Team Leaders: Brittany Howard, Mental Health America and Rob Tasman, LA Catholic Conference Media Team Leaders: Denise Bottcher, LA AARP and Ryan West, LA Progress Research: Tim Mathis, LA Budget Project Education: Alex Mikulich and Jordan Shannon, (Puentes) Membership Recruitment: Mary Williams, LA Association of Non-profits At-Large Representatives: Nancy McPherson, LA AARP Blaine Grimes, Campus Federal Union (LSU) • Specific strategic action plans were developed for the following focus areas of the Organizing Committee: Legislative and Political Organizing; Membership and Recruitment; Media and Communications; Research, and Education. • Benefits and responsibilities of membership for individuals and faith-based, educational, non-profit, and business organizations were developed. First-steps include development of formal membership sign-on procedures and development of membership through current participants. Creation of the executive OC included development of a consensus building model for decision-making with member organizations and use of quorum and simple majority for decisions made by the executive committee. 4.
